1. What is the current situation in Lebanon following the escalation of hostilities in the Middle East?

Lebanon has been hit hard by the escalation of hostilities in the Middle East, resulting in more than 1,000 victims and 1 million internally displaced people since the beginning of the conflict (source: UN OCHA).

2. How is the Siss Philanthropy Foundation responding to this crisis?

Moved by this tragedy and because the Foundation has known local partners on the ground, we have activated our Rapid Response Fund. This Fund aims to provide significant assistance to Lebanon by supporting impactful organizations on the ground selected by WISE Philanthropy Advisors.

3. What are the objectives of this Fund?

We aim to raise a maximum of individual donations of at least CHF 10,000 by October 15, 2024. Our initial commitment is CHF 20,000 to encourage co-financing. This fund will support NGOs working in emergency humanitarian aid and psychosocial support for children.
